You can get a vaccine if you are uninsured and/or undocumented. Getting vaccinated will have no impact on immigration status.

ALL New Jerseyans age 12 and older are eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine*.

According to the CDC:



Receiving a COVID-19 vaccine cannot cause you to be magnetic:

COVID-19 vaccines do not contain ingredients that can produce an electromagnetic field at the site of your injection



People who receive the COVID-19 vaccines do not shed the COVID-19 virus:

None of the vaccines authorized for use in the United States contain a live virus



Being near someone who received the vaccine cannot affect your menstrual cycle: Many things can affect menstrual cycles, including stress, problems with sleep, and changes in diet or exercise.



** The Pfizer/ BioNTech vaccine is the only vaccine authorized for 12-17 year old individuals; it may not be administered at all sites. Please contact the vaccination site before your appointment to determine availability and consent requirements.*

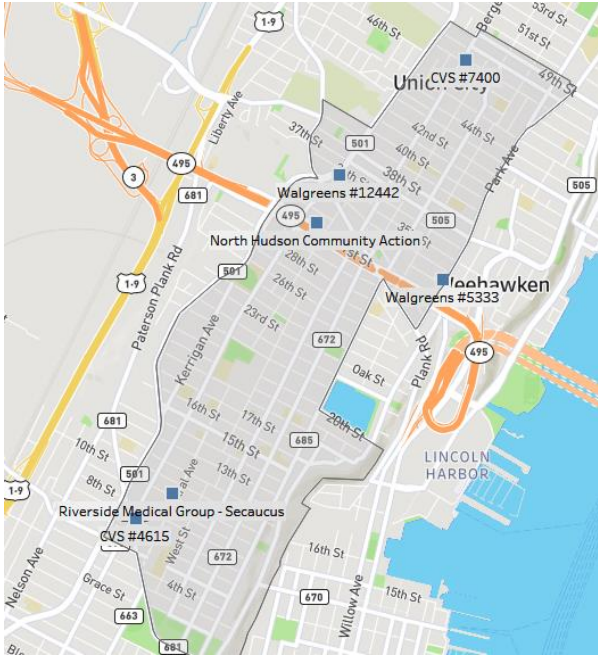

You can use your NJ Earned Sick Leave to get your vaccine!

Employers must pay up to 40 hours of NJ Earned Sick Leave per year to most full- and part-time employees

Medicaid members can schedule transportation to a vaccine appointment by calling Modivcare at **1-866-527-9933** at least 48 hours before the appointment.
