Roberto Sandoval is a native of San Diego and currently lives in Los Angeles. He has served on numerous committees and boards of Latinx/Latina/Latino Deaf, DeafBlind, DeafDisabled, Hard of Hearing and LateDeafened (DDBDDHHLD) and sign language interpreter organizations.

In 2017, Roberto was the co-curator for the Dyer Arts Center at Rochester Institute of Technology's National Technical Institute for the Deaf (NTID) featured the artwork of Latinx/Latina/Latino Deaf artists during the "Arte del Corazón" exhibit. In 2018 and 2019, Roberto was one of the Deaf Arts Jubilee presenters teaching Mexican Arts. The Deaf Arts Jubilee brings together Deaf high school students from across Southern California for a day full of exposure to arts and culture. Roberto is currently the co-curator for the NTID Dyer Arts Center which will feature the artwork of Latinx/Latina/Latino DDBDDHHLD artists on its website from 2021 to 2022.
